Option 1:

Name:

In this project, you will work in groups of 4-6 to create a commemorative magazine focusing on a specific genocide studied in class. Your magazine should aim to inform readers about the historical background, causes, impact, and legacy of the genocide. Through this project, you will demonstrate your understanding of the complexity of genocide and its lasting effects.

Assignment Objectives:

- To deepen your understanding of a specific genocide through research and analysis.
- To develop your skills in collaboration, communication, and creativity.
- To create a visually appealing and informative magazine that educates readers about the chosen genocide.

Task Description:

- 1. Review the events leading up to, including and the aftermath of 1984.
- 2. Research this genocide further, focusing on its historical context, causes, key events, impact on affected populations, and legacy.
- 3. Design a magazine layout, including a cover page, table of contents, articles, images, and captions.
- 4. Write informative articles that provide a comprehensive overview of the chosen genocide.
